Rules & Regulations:

- The competition is open to all students attending primary, secondary, vocational or tertiary institutions in St. Lucia.
- Entries to the competition can only be made through the school which the student attends; 1 entry per student.
- Each school is allowed two entries per category.
- Attach a cover page to each essay, stating the topic, the student's name, age and school and the total number of words.
- Essays are to be typed in regular font, size 12, single spacing.
- Essays will be graded on grammar (15), accuracy of information (30), content (25), relevance to the topic (20) and writing style (10).
- Name all sources of reference.
- By accepting the prize, winners agree to be featured in any promotional material organised by LUCELEC. For further information or queries on the competition, please call LUCELEC at 457-4512.

The panel of judges will consist of selected English Language teachers and Lucelec personnel. All completed essays should be submitted to the Principal of the attending school, who in turn will deliver them to the nearest Lucelec Office - that is the Rodney Bay, Sans Souci, Soufriere or Vieux Fort offices. Essays should be addressed to: The Managing Director, Schools Essay Competition, Lucelec. The deadline for submission is Tuesday 17th May, 2005.
